

**Foundational Overview: Made in His Image**

- Genesis 1:26-27 – God created you, loves you, knows you, and called you for His purpose and glory.
  
- The purpose we are called to: 1) love God and 2) love our neighbor
  - If we do not know the love of God, we will not be able to love our neighbor, and our husbands are our closest neighbors.
  
- What am I focused on?
  - *Focused on my works*: My life may look like it is put together, polished and shiny. Yet, I am not looking at the glory of God and thus cannot reflect it or offer it to others. If I am focused on what I do, my heart will be empty and the “water” inside of me will be stagnant and dirty.
  - *Focused on Christ*: My life may not look put together, but I am filled with living water when I am fixing my eyes on God. Because I know Him, I drink of his love, can rest in Him, and can pour out his love to others.
  
- The Lord chose us, so we must choose Him:
  1. Be in His Word
  2. Believe His Word
  3. Follow His Word (do it)
