#### **Thorns of Remaining Sin: Galatians 5:19-21**

Defensive, denies sin, irritable, envious, difficulty getting along, comparisons, critical, lie, caustic humor, jealous, pity parties, demanding spirit, quick to blame, fearful, unapproachable, self-protective, worries about what others think, quick to speak, insecure, feel unappreciated, unbroken, blind to her true heart condition, self-centered, self-consumed, feels sorry for self, oh woe is me, dwells in sinfulness, holds back love, not a team player, wants the glory, wants the credit, judgmental and judging, ungrateful, needs to be in control...

#### **Spirit of Christ: Galatians 5:22-24**

Believes the best, able to hear truth spoken in love, receives correction with peace, willing to see sin and confess it, listens well, consider others higher than self, takes responsibility, confesses sin, admits wrong, vulnerable, thankful in ALL things, submits to authority (inside and out), seeks God's approval not man's, repentant, grateful heart, can say 'I was wrong', secure in Christ, content, draws others to Christ, broken, dwells on the gospel and its mercy, receives mercy and gives it, others oriented, finds purpose, fulfillment in Christ alone, draws other to Christ, servant's heart, loving, nothing hidden, teachable heart, truth teller, other's oriented.
