


THE GOSPEL


SIN AND DEATH: Genesis 2:16-17; Genesis 3:6; Romans 5:12; Ephesians 2:1-3; Colossians 1:21


Show the GREAT EXCHANGE

GOD OFFERS HIS SON: Romans 3:10-11, 5:6-8, 6:23; 2 Corinthians 5:21a; Colossians 1:21



The corruption and disease of sin continue from Adam and Eve to all their children. No one is born righteous. No one seeks God. The entire human race is at enmity with God, entrenched in sin, rebellious, defiant, idolatrous, and therefore, separated from Him. The penalty for sin is death and eternal separation from God. But God, in His great love and mercy, provided His only Son to stand in our place. Jesus willingly died on the cross and took upon Himself the punishment that all deserve for their sin.

JESUS GIVES HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS: 2 Corinthians 5:21b; Ephesians 2:8-9; Colossians 1:22, Ezekiel 36:26



By faith, those who trust in Jesus for the forgiveness of their sins receive eternal life instead of the eternal death that they deserve. Jesus gives them a new heart and restores them to a right relationship with God. They are indwelt and sealed by the Holy Spirit and become children of God. Those who once were spiritually dead and separated from God become new creations in Christ!



The new heart that God gives us through salvation results in new behavior in our lives. God saves us even when we are sinners, but He doesn't just leave us there; He also gives us the Holy Spirit! Although we do attain perfection in this life, God calls us to walk with Him and strive for ever-increasing righteousness.
